Items not accepted: plastic bags, mirrors, plate glass, light bulbs, ceramics, tissues, wet paper, containers contaminated with food products, aluminum foil, kitchen waste.

Keep this card on your fridge for a quick reminder about recycling.

Collection Days

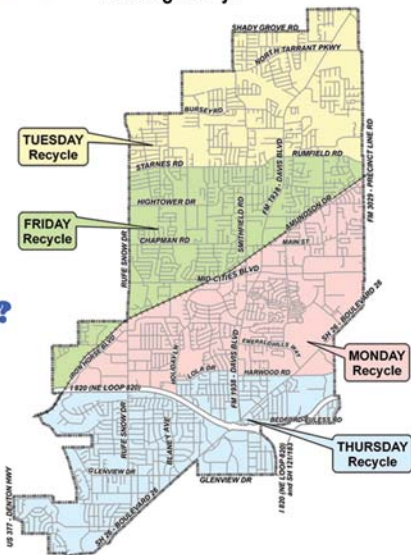
Recyclables are collected once a week on one of your regular garbage collection days. Bins should be placed curbside by 7 a.m. Please secure the lid on your bin to prevent items from blowing away.

Recycle Bins

Recycle bins may be obtained at City Hall, 7301 NE Loop 820 or the Recreation Center, 6720 NE Loop 820. The first bin is free. Additional bins are \$8.26 each.
