

Notice to All NRH Water Customers

Efficient water use is important all the time, not just during the summer months. That is why the City of North Richland Hills and other cities in Tarrant County have extended water conservation measures year round.

Throughout the year outdoor watering is prohibited between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m., except by hand or soaker hose. All sprinkler systems should be set to operate in the early morning or late evening, when the sun and temperatures are less likely to cause evaporation.

Remember, water is a precious natural resource that we must use wisely and protect for future generations. North Richland Hills and neighboring communities are partnering together to make this water conservation effort uniform across Tarrant County.
