Below are requirements for a business to have a Mobile Food Unit (MFU) on premises in the City of North Richland Hills.

All requirements must be met in order for a MFU operate onsite.

- MFU may not operate at locations where on premise alcohol consumption is prohibited**, Sec. 18-287(f)
- NRH MFU Verification of Permission to Use Location Form submitted** (NRH staff can notarize), Sec. 18-282(a)(12)
- MFU must set up 150 feet or less from restroom facilities** (measure distance on Google Maps), Sec. 18-285(b)
- MFU must be 50 feet or more from an intersection** (measure distance on Google Maps), Sec. 18-285(a)(4)
- Must not be set up within a visibility triangle**, Sec. 18-285(a)(3)
- Must not be set up on vacant property or other temporary structure**, Sec. 18-285(a)(1)
- Must be set up on a paved asphalt/concrete surface**, Sec. 18-285(a)(2)
- Must not be set up in an area where standing/parking of vehicles is prohibited**, Sec. 18-285(a)(3), Sec. 18-287(d)
- Must not utilize any business parking spaces or park in a fire lane**, Sec. 18-287(c)
- May only operate in the area of the property designated in the application submitted by the property owner/landlord** (per submitted site plan), Sec. 18-287(c)

**As a reminder (Sec. 18-286):**

- MFUs must be removed from the property nightly
- MFUs may set up at the following:
  - Commercial or Industrial properties where alcohol consumption is not prohibited by law
    - During business operating hours; 7 am - 11 pm is the maximum allowed time frame
  - Residential properties up to twice annually for private parties, block parties, etc.
    - 7am – 9pm is the maximum allowed time frame
  - Mixed Use/Transit Oriented Development
    - During business operating hours; 6 am – 11pm maximum allowed time frame
    - May only operate up to three hours in a street parking spot
  - Special Events: permitted Community Special Events
- MFUs are subject to inspection every time they set up in North Richland Hills
  - **Operators must be prepared for unscheduled inspections at all times when operating in NRH**
  - No home prepared foods, operations must CEASE if imminent hazard exists (fire, loss of power/water)
  - MFUs must be readily movable, comply with all NRH laws and ordinances, control trash and noise
